At last night's council meeting (3 Oct) it was agreed that a decision on the future location of facilities currently provided at the Armstrong Hall would be postponed from 19 Oct until the new year. This will allow us more time to fully consider the results of the consultation and acquire further information on funding, designs and governance issues which have been raised and to better inform the decision making process. The results of the consultation will be made publically available in due course and we are committed to holding the requested Town Meeting at an appropriate time prior to any decision being made. South Gloucestershire Council will be making its decision on the location of the library separately, most likely in November.
