

## **Under Milk Wood by Dylan Thomas in Thornbury on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2017**

***“It is spring, moonless night in the small town, starless and bible-black, the cobbledstreets silent and the hunched courtiers'-and-rabbits' wood limping invisible down to the sloeback, slow, black, crowblack, fishingboat-bobbing sea...”***

Set in the fictitious fishing village of Llareggub, this twenty four hour peek into the lives and loves of the likes of Captain Cat, Polly Garter and Willy Nilly has continued to enthral its audiences ever since.
